Rules: Current NRA Highpower Rifle Rules will govern.

Rifles Allowed: NRA Highpower Rifle Rules 3.1 thru 3.5 will govern Service or Match Rifle with Metallic Sights only. Tactical Rifle with any Optical Sight. Only rifles chambered in 5.56 mm (.223), 7.62 mm (308 and 30-06), 260 Remington, 6.5x47 Lapua, 6x47 Lapua, 6.5 Grendel, and 6mmAR are permitted. Competition Open To: USMC and other U.S Service Members. Civilian adults or supervised juniors (+16 years of age) members of PRPC, NRA, HRA or other State Shooting Associations. Membership to Pu'uloa Rifle & Pistol Club or the NRA is not required to participate. Non-membership as space permits. PRPC reserves the right to refuse entry to individuals.

Entries: Postal or Range Entries Accepted for Individual and Team Matches must be made by completing an NRA SR-1 Card and sending them with a check or money order payable to: Pu'uloa Rifle & Pistol Club. Mail all paper work to Kevin Nakagami P.O. Box 10471 Honolulu, Hawaii 96816. You must list a phone number and/or email address in order to be notified of any changes. Postal Entries must be received by Friday, 2 days before a scheduled match.

Entries Limited: Report to Pu'uloa RTF for registration. When registered competitors have filled all the assigned squadded positions, the match entry process will be closed.

***Note:** In order to speed up the Entry process, please print and fill out the SR-1 card that can be found on the PRPC website, www.puuloa.com and bring it with you on match day. A \$5.00 late Entry Fee will be charged to competitors that do not confirm attendance by Friday, 2 days before a scheduled match. Send an attendance confirmation to prpchawaii@gmail.com or call (808) 256 9817. If a Postal Entry is received no other verification of attendance is needed.

Squadding: Squadding, target assignments, and scorecards will be issued by match officials.

Classification: NRA classification system

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$2.00 will be charged for each challenge and must be paid prior to the challenge being processed.

Pullers/Scoring: Competitors will pull targets and score for each other. Or, competitors are allowed to furnish their own puller.

National Match Service/Match Rifle Course of Fire: National Match Course 800AGG (88 shots, including sighters)

Match 1: 200 yards, slow fire, standing position. 2 sighter shots and 20 record shots in 22 minutes.

Match 2: 200 yards, rapid fire, sitting position. 2 sighter shots in 2 minutes then two strings of 10 record shots in 60 seconds.

Match 3: 300 yards, rapid fire, prone position. 2 sighter shots in 2 minutes then two strings of 10 record shots in 70 seconds.

Match 4: 600 yards, slow fire, prone position. 2 sighter shots and 20 record shots in 22 minutes.

Match 5: Slow Fire Aggregate of match 1 and 4

Match 6: Rapid Fire Aggregate of match 2 and 3

Match 7: Overall Match Winner. The aggregate score of matches 1 thru 4.

Tactical Rifle Course of Fire: 800AGG (88 shots, including sighters)

1st Stage of Fire: 2 sighter shots and 20 record shots in 22 minutes. 200 yards, slow fire, prone position.

2nd Stage of Fire: 2 sighter shots in 2 minutes then two strings of 10 record shots in 60 seconds. 200 yards, rapid fire, prone position.

3rd Stage of Fire: 2 sighter shots in 2 minutes then two strings of 10 record shots in 70 seconds. 300 yards, rapid fire, prone position.

4th Stage of Fire: 2 sighter shots and 20 record shots in 22 minutes. 600 yards, slow fire, prone position.

Special Notes

1. Reloaded ammunition shall be the responsibility of the competitor.
2. Chamber flags/open bolt indicators are required in the rifles action and can be purchased at the match. Rifles are to be pointed downrange or in a safe direction at all times. Safety is the responsibility of all competitors.
3. Competitors will be asked to help in range safety, set up/ clean up, and comply with safety rules and show good sportsmanship. Failure to do so will result in a disqualification, forfeit fees/awards or barred from future PRPC activities. We are guests of the USMC and our future PRPC activities depend on all of our actions.
4. To be eligible to purchase ammunition and or weapons (M1 Garand, M1 Carbine, etc.) from the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP). Purchasers must submit to CMP, proof of age (+21 years old), USA citizenship, membership in a state rifle association (Hawaii Rifle Association) or CMP enrolled club (PRPC), and participation in a highpower rifle marksmanship activity (50 shots minimum) in one or more CMP or NRA sanctioned competitions. A PRPC Marksmanship Certificate will only be given to competitors who participate using a center fire rifle with metallic sights. Prohibitions

1. Alcoholic beverages on the range at any time.

2. Children under 16 years of age and pets are not permitted on the range.
3. Spectators who are disruptive shall be escorted out by Military Police.
4. Vehicles on the range, park in the gravel lot at the Pu'uloa Rifle Range Tunnel Entrance.
5. Tracer and armor piercing ammunition.
